Spill Control Procedures

- 1. Stop the spill
- 2. Decontaminate (people), give first aid
- 3. Contain the spill
- 4. Isolate the area
- Report the spill
- 6. Clean up the spill
- 7. Decontaminate area as necessary
- 8. Dispose of contaminants
